- 1. The meet will be conducted according to the MSHSL Rules.
- 2. Registration will be done through Athletic.net. Instructions are below on how to join our meet.
- 3. This meet will be a seeded meet. All Entries are Due by 9:00 PM on Wednesday, May 1st. Competitor Numbers will be sent out by May 2nd at 9:00 AM. Please put these on your athlete's hand. We will do a scratch/add section in our coaches meeting and then print out updated heat/worker sheets.
- 4. Team Camps are to be set up outside of the infield. The infield is to only be used for warming up
- 5. <u>There is to be no food or throwing implements while on the in-field.</u>
- 6. Entry Limits Include:
  - a. 4 throwers and 4 Jumpers/School for Field Events
  - b. 2 Relays Per Team
  - c. 4 Athletes/School in all Running Events
- 7. There will be no preliminary heats. All events are final.
- 8. Field events will receive 3 attempts/athlete. No Finals
- 9. Times will be FAT.
- 10. 1-2 Field Event Worker will be provided by each team to clerk or assist and field events and/or help with exchange zones.
  - a. Lakeview will provide workers to move hurdles, run results, assist the field events as needed, and all other duties as assigned.
- 11. Lakeview will provide Starting Blocks Only 1/4" or shorter pyramid spikes are allowed
- 12. Results can be found on Athletic.net. We will be using live results.
- 13. Team points will be scored in the following fashion: 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1
  - a. Awards to be given out to top 6 finishes.
- 14. Starting Heights for High Jump and Pole Vault will be decided at the start of the meet
- 15. A concession stand will be available.
